## Caldwell County 4-H Livestock Judging




WHO: Caldwell County youth between the ages of 9-18 (Must be 9 by Jan. 1, 2025).

Any youth interested in participating in the 2025 season, MUST attend both Safety Orientation Meetings with a parent or guardian.



# Honey Raisin Muffins

1/2 cup + 2 tablespoons all purpose flour

1/2 cup + 2 tablespoons whole wheat flour

% teaspoon baking powder

- 1. Combine flours, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon and salt in a bowl and set aside.
- 2. In a large mixing bowl, combine cereal, milk and honey; let stand for 2 minutes to soften. Stir in egg whites, applesauce 6. Cool 10 minutes before

14 teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon salt

2 cups bran flake cereal with raisins

and oil; mix well.

- 3. Add dry ingredients and stir until moistened.
- 4. Fill a greased or paperlined muffin pan 1/3 full.
- 5. Bake at 400°F for 15-18 minutes.
- removing from pan.

1 cup skim milk

1/2 cup honey

2 egg whites

3 tablespoons

unsweetened applesauce

2 tablespoons canola oil

Yield: 12 muffins.
